30% Grenache, 30% Carignan, 20% Syrah, 20% Mourvedre

Albaret's 2009 Faugeres Tradition showcases Syrah, Grenache, Carignan and Mourvedre. Elderberry and mulberry are suffused with peat, crushed stone, and savory, saliva-inducing soy. A red meat element I associate with Mourvedre emerges as the wine takes on air. This offers a satisfying sense of substantiality allied an element of primary juiciness that's welcome but cannot be taken for granted from 2009. The finish is faintly gum-numbing and not especially juicy but still offers impressive sheer persistence of fruit, meat, and mineral matter.
